The Management, Professional Staff and the Delanco Skating Club invite you to participate in the New Jersey Open Invitational. The date for this year's event is **May 9 & 10, 2026**. The invitational will include all USARS Youth Level A, B, and C Events, and all USARS Adult Events. **We will skate the first and second requirements as listed for the April 1st National Elimination Draw.** Senior, Junior, Cadet and Youth figure events will not have a national draw listed. They will skate all figures as listed for the Regional Draw.

All USA Roller Skating rules will be followed as outlined for the 2026 National Roller Skating Championships.

Entry fees are \$40.00 for the first event and \$35.00 for each additional event.
All World Skate entry fees are \$50.00 for every event.
A \$15.00 fee will be charged additionally for combined events.

Mail-In Entry deadline is postmarked by April 6, 2026. Meet Entry System deadline is April 11, 2026.

All spectators will be charged a \$5.00 admission fee.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All skaters must hold a current 2026 USA Roller Skating Full Membership Card or an Event Only Competition Membership if they are registering in official USARS events. (Youth Level A and B events, World Skate, Youth Events, Elite Events and all Adult Events). Skaters registering in just Level C events may skate with a Star Skate USA Roller Sports Membership (\$15.00). Skaters who have an Event Only USA Roller Sports Membership (\$25.00) may compete in as many events as they qualify to skate at this contest only. Event Only membership is only valid for 5 days....please be aware and purchase no earlier than the Wednesday before the contest. However, registering earlier than that for an Event Only membership is preferred by USA Roller Sports. If you do register earlier you will need to email Brent Benson at bbenson@usarollersports.org to inform him the dates and competition you need the Event Membership for. Brent will need the skater's name and membership number that was created on Sport80.

- 1) All official events will be run using the official national rules.
- 2) World Skate Dance, Freestyle and Pairs Events will be judged using the RollArt scoring. Please provide copies of your content sheets in your music folder or email them to NJOpenMusic@gmail.com by April 30, 2026.
- 3) World Skate Figure Events: will skate all their figure requirements as listed. The Loop will be skated last.

Challenge Up

Figure Skaters may enter up to 2 USARS circle events and 2 USARS loop events. (Note: Entry in a World Skate Figure Event counts as an entry into both a figure event and a loop event.) Dance Skaters may enter up to 2 USARS Solo Dance and 2 USARS Team Dance events. In addition, age eligible skaters may also register to skate the Special Adult Dance Events.

Youth Level A skaters may challenge up to a higher age group. Level C skaters may only challenge Level B or A events (only if they have a full USARS membership). Level B skaters may only challenge up to Level A events. Freshman and Sophomore skaters may only move up to Jr. WS, Sr. WS or Advanced events as age eligible.

All adult skaters may only enter events where they **are age eligible to skate**. Adults may challenge up to the next level event (bronze to silver, silver to gold). Adult Bronze Levels may not challenge up to Adult Gold Levels.

Special Adult Dance Events In addition to the regular USARS Solo and Team Dance events there will be additional solo and team dance Special Events. These events will be open to all adult skaters 18 and over.

Special Team Dance Requirements Are: Casino Tango and Denver Shuffle
Special Solo Dance Requirements Are: Double Cross Waltz and Denver Shuffle

Age Eligibility is determined by the skater's age as of January 1, 2026

Final Events All Standard Events will be skated as a two figure or two dance final events regardless of entry. World Skate Events are always final events.



FROM THE:

- North - NJ Turnpike South to Exit 6 (PA Turnpike Extension Exit), Exit off of the extension before getting into PA on the Rt. 130 South Exit. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- West - PA Turnpike across bridge into New Jersey. Get off at the first exit after the bridge onto Rt. 130 South. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- South- NJ Turnpike North to Exit 4, Rt. 73 North to Rt. 130 North, Rt. 130 North to Delanco (about 4 or 5 miles) to Creek Road Jug Handle Exit. Follow Creek Rd. after exiting Rt. 130 - Turn left at first street (about 300 yards) - The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.

If you are using a GPS navigation system or Map Quest.com to get to the skating center the address is 1775 Creek Road, Edgewater Park, NJ. Our mailing address is Delanco, NJ but there is another Creek Road in Delanco, and it will take you to the wrong Creek Road. (Our parking lot is in Edgewater Park.) **If you ask for The Rink in Delanco NJ, Apple Maps and Google Maps know the location.**
